- x For full time faculty members in Tiers 3, high demand premiums will be included in

- x For adjunct faculty members, high demand premiumils be paid in a lump sum for each quarter. Each quarter's premium will be based on the percent of 1.0 FTEF worked that quarter,

- up to 1.0 FTEF cumulatively for the academic year. Every effort will be made to include premiums in the third paycheck issue of that quarter's teaching contract.
- x If after all faculty have been compensated, there is money remaining from the Deighand allocation, then the Agent and the College agree to bargain those monies.
